Decorative planters

Geoff Hodge looks at what's available in plastic pot planters



TOT all of us are blessed with a large garden - and some gardeners only have a patio or narrow balcony to grow on. Even large gardens tend to have a patio area where you can relax and entertain friends - the so called 'outdoor room'. Whether large or small. all gardens will have at least a couple of containers for growing plants in.

Just about every plant can be grown in containers - vou just need to match their growth with the size of the container. And, of course. there's a huge range of styles and materials available. Your containers should be seen as part of the garden, match its style and your personal taste.

Stone, metal and terracotta planters are all available, but they're heavy, making them difficult to move around.

but the weight is useful for tall plants in windy areas. And there's the other possible drawback with some terracotta pots - they can crack in cold and frosty weather.

especially for winter protection.

Plastic is much cheaper and more economical - although sticking a black plastic bucket on the patio isn't exactly the most ornamental and stylish option! Luckily, plastic containers come in a wide range of styles. colours and designs, and some even make a fairly realistic stab at looking like terracotta, lead and other metals.

Here's my roundup of ornamental and decorative plastic planters. As we all have our own tastes. I've chosen my favourite - but vou'll probably prefer something else! All measurements are

external dimensions. The sizes for round containers are given as the diameter at the top.




Coffee fertiliser **RRP £9.99**

Notcutts have come up with a novel use for some of the 27,680 tonnes of coffee waste that goes to landfill each year with a new coffee-based fertiliser.
